

Positive Purposeful Behaviour

The Whole School Detention System was introduced in June last year.

Last term we reviewed the WSD and consulted with students, parents and staff.

Thank you to all the students that contributed and following the consultation we have made some changes to improve the WSD system



There will be 30 and 60 minute detentions

Introduce a warning system for 2 of the 6 identified low level disruptions.

1. Disrupting a lesson or learning activity.
2. Unacceptable or uncivilised behaviour in and around school.

Step 1 Verbal Warning

Step 2 Name on the board (name written down or radioed through to team leader at break or lunch)

Step 3 30 mins

Step 4 60 mins

- Poster guidance in every classroom



Automatic WSD for 4 of the 6 identified low level disruptions

3. Arriving late to lessons or school **30 mins**
 4. Incorrect Uniform and /or equipment (in addition to confiscation, sending home) **30 mins**
 5. Failure to meet deadlines Coursework, homework etc) **60 mins**
 6. Rude offensive or challenging behaviour to staff. e.g. continuous low level disruption, fighting, inappropriate language **60 mins**
- Poster guidance in every classroom



Staff will continue to give students the white top copy. The top white copy should be kept and shown to your parents.

Level 4 and 5 very serious incidents will continue to be logged separately

It is the students responsibility to ensure they attend the detention the following day and check the notice board for the room.

There will be a list of teachers on the board that are taking the detention that evening. This means they will not be available for you to go and speak to them about your work.



Additional sanctions for those students that continually disrupt learning or continually fail to attend detentions.

There is a tiered system

DNTU

- 1** Lunch time detention the following day
- 3** YM Meeting. YM escort
- 6** HOY Parent meeting. Sign agreement
- 9+** DHT/HT meeting with parents. Sign agreement



WSD

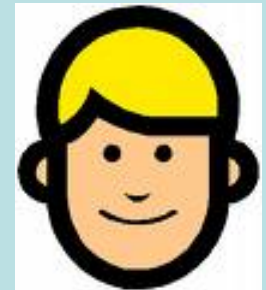
- 5** Student on report to form tutor. Tutor mentoring
- 10** YM meeting. Targets set. Phone call home, minutes sent home, on report to YM.
- 15** HOY meeting with parents Sat detention
- 20** SLT Red meeting with parents. ABC, lunch time workshops to improve behaviour. Presentation.
- 25+** DHT/HT, possible exclusion for persistent defiant behaviour

Rewards

Half termly prize draw in each year group for those students that have not had a single WSD that Half term.

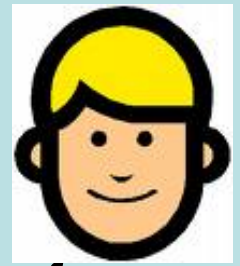
Weekly Reward for the tutor groups with the least number of WSD.

70 Cranford Shield points for the best tutor group, 60 for the second, 50 for the third.



These rewards are purely to reward the students and tutor groups that do not get WSD.

The whole School Reward System is going to be Improved and students will be invited to contribute to this.



Fresh New Year Start for all students

Once a student has accumulated a number of detentions they sometimes see no point in trying to clear them and just give up. In order to give all students the opportunity to make a real effort to improve their behaviour all students will have the opportunity for a fresh start from Tuesday morning and start from 0 again.
