AS / ADVANCED LEVEL COURSES – Single Award (5 periods a week) – need to have achieved a C in Maths and English to go from Year 12 to 13 if not gained already

Design & Technology	45	B in a DT subject
Drama & Theatre Studies	40	C in English <u>and</u> Grade C in drama (if studied)
Economics	45	C in both Maths and English
English Literature	45	two GCSE grade Bs in any of the following: English language, English literature and media studies
English Literature with Language Combined	45	two GCSE grade Bs in any of the following: English language, English literature and media studies
French	45	B in French or pass a mother tongue assessment
Geography	45	C in English <u>OR</u> grade C in Geography (if taken)
German	45	B in German or pass a mother tongue assessment
History	45	B in History (if taken) <u>and</u> Grade C in English
Information Communication Technology	40	B pass in science <u>or</u> English <u>and</u> grade C maths OR Merit (equivalent to GCSE grades AABB) at level 2 in OCR Nationals in ICT (i.e. must be equivalent to 4 GCSEs – not less)
Mathematics (Mechanics or Stats)	45	B in higher tier maths
Further Mathematics	50	A in higher tier maths
Media Studies	40	two GCSE grade Bs in any of the following: English language, English literature and media studies
Punjabi	45	B in Punjabi or pass a mother tongue assessment
Physics	45	BB for double science with minimum Grade C in maths
Physical Education	40	C in full course PE and grade CC in science GCSE or equivalent
Psychology	45	B in English and grade C in maths and grade CC in science
Religious Education	45	B in any of RE, history, sociology, geography <u>and</u> a B in English
Sociology	45	B in English and Grade C in sociology (if taken)
Urdu	45	B at GCSE or pass a mother tongue assessment

LEVEL 3 VOCATIONAL – Double Award (10 periods a week) – need to have achieved a C in Maths and English to go from Year 12 to 13 if not gained already. Students cannot do 2 Level 3 Applied courses.

Art and Design	40	C in Art or DT and pass Cranford's drawing test
Business	40	D in maths and C in English <u>OR</u> BTEC Level 2 Merit in business
Information Communication Technology	40	D in maths and grade C in English <u>and</u> Applied OCR National ICT Merit (grade AABB) or equivalent (if ICT taken at KS4)
Science	40	CC or above in GCSE double science (OR a Merit in BTec First science) and D in maths
Travel & Tourism	40	D in GCSE English and GCSE leisure & tourism grade B (if taken at KS4) OR a Merit at level 2 in Travel and Tourism
Health and Social Care	40	CC or above in GCSE science and a grade C in GCSE English OR a Merit at level 2 in Health & Social Care

BTEC / OCR / Edexcel LEVEL 2 COURSES (1 YEAR) - at least 5 GCSEs at grades A*- E with a minimum of two at grade D or above. To progress from L2 to L3 must achieve at least grade C in both GCSE English and maths by the end of L2 course. COPE level 1 = E/F & COPE level 2 = B
